
What We're Learning this Month Language Arts

This theme for this unit is "Growing and Learning". Each unit is six weeks long and ends with a benchmark assessment. Each week a vocabulary and spelling list will be sent home. Students will be tested on their words on Fridays. Please help your child study for these tests so they not only perform well on the assessment but have long-term retention of the information.

The first few weeks of spelling tests may seem fairly easy, as they are a review of the previous year's knowledge. Each week the words will increase in difficulty. Students are given differentiated spelling tests based on their level of proficiency and learning needs. More details will be given at our back to school night.

<u>Math</u>

The focus this month is multiplication. Even though this is usually a skill that is taught latter in the year, the curriculum we use teaches it at the beginning of the year to build proficiency throughout the school year. We will still be focusing on addition and subtraction throughout the school year and students will be time tested on addition and subtraction facts the first quarter of the year. Please help your child study these basic facts each night in order to increase their fluency and build on the ability to comprehend more complex mathematical concepts.
